FISHING TOURNAMENT FAQ'S

How much does it cost?

The cost to register for the tournament is \$5.

Who can register?

Registration is open to anyone **5 years of age and older**. The tournament will be split into two age brackets, one for 5 - 16 year olds and another for ages 17 + (each age bracket will have an individual overall winner).

How will scoring be totaled?

Upon catching a qualifying fish (**1/2 pound or greater**) participants will find the nearest volunteer who will weigh each fish. One (1) point will be awarded for each ounce of weight. For example, a fish weighing 1 pound would yield 16 points (1 pound = 16 ounces); a fish weighing 2 pounds would yield 32 points, etc. Fish must weigh at least ½ pound to qualify for scoring. The total score of each participant's qualifying fish will be calculated at the end of the tournament.

How will prizes be awarded?

At the end of the tournament, prizes will be given for the highest point total from each age bracket. There will also be a prize for the largest bass and catfish caught during the tournament.

Where can I fish?

Fishing will only be permitted from the **bank and pier**.

How do I register?

A general registration form is available at City Hall or can be downloaded on our website at cityofcreedmoor.org/ProgramRegistration. Submit the completed form with payment to City Hall located at 111 Masonic Street, or you can pay by credit card by emailing the registration form to recreation@cityofcreedmoor.org and indicating you wish to be contacted for a credit card phone payment.

Any Violation of the rules as set forth above may be grounds for disqualification at the sole discretion of the program administrator.
