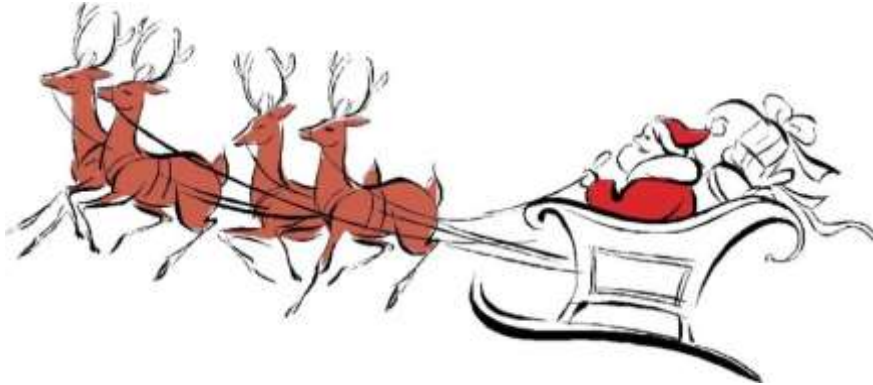


Christmas Parade Application

INFORMATION FOR PARTICIPANTS

Applications to participate in the 2018 Creedmoor Christmas Parade are now being accepted. Interested participants should submit their **application and \$20 donation** by mail to Creedmoor Christmas Parade, P.O. Box 765, Creedmoor, N.C. 27522 or email completed applications to events@cityofcreedmoor.org. Paper applications are available and accepted at Creedmoor City Hall, 111 Masonic Street, Creedmoor.

Applications will only be considered when we have received the completed application and entry fee. Donations benefit the Creedmoor Police Department's Shop with a Cop Program.

**All applications must be received by
Wednesday, November 21, 2018.**

Accepted entrants will be notified via the email address provided on the application by November 27 along with additional parade line up information, and other pertinent details for the event.

The Creedmoor Christmas Parade is a fun-filled event for both participants and spectators. Parade instructions and rules are designed to remind participants that sometimes even the most innocent actions can provoke significant problems in a crowded area. The rules are in place to ensure that we have an orderly, safe and joyful parade. Please communicate these rules to all members of your parade entry.

Instructions for Participants

SATURDAY DECEMBER 1, 2018 11:00 AM

REQUIRED SIGN IN

- WHEN Registration begins at 9:00 am and promptly closes at 10:00 am.
- WHERE The Parade Check-in location will be at the intersection of Main Street and East Church Street.
- WHO One representative from your group must sign in. All vehicles participating in the parade must be in the staging area by 10:00 am and a driver must remain with vehicle at all times.

LINE-UP

- WHEN *All participants must be on site, registered and lined-up by 10:30 a.m.*
- WHERE Beginning at the intersection of Main Street and East Church Street. Each group will line-up by position determined by parade officials. Line-up positions will be emailed and posted online a few days preceding the parade. **Group entries should plan to meet at South Granville High School parking lot for loading.**

PARADE ROUTE

The parade will begin at the intersection of Main Street and East Church Street and continue north on Main Street. The Parade will end at the intersection of Main Street (PNC Bank) and Lake Road. **DO NOT** stop at the intersection to unload - please continue to South Granville High School parking lot for unloading.

PARADE RULES

Please communicate these rules to everyone in your group. Failure to comply with these rules and/or instructions from parade officials could result in removal from the parade line-up this year and in future years. Thank you for your understanding and compliance.

- There is only **ONE** Santa allowed in the parade. **DO NOT** put Santa in your display. Santa will appear in the parade directly from the North Pole.
- All hands and feet must be kept inside vehicles and floats at all times and everyone must remain seated. Floats must come to a complete stop before participants disembark. Absolutely no one may jump from a float while it is in motion.
- **Do not** leave the parade line-up until the parade ends at Main Street and Hwy 56 (CVS). Group entries should continue on to South Granville High School for unloading.
- Adult supervision for all children under the age of 14 is required at all times in the staging area and during the parade, in addition to the driver of the vehicle.
- We are asking that ADULTS take on the sole responsibility of throwing the candy. We are asking this to increase the trajectory of the candy. Candy that lands on the roadway provides an unnecessary danger to children who can be run over by parade vehicles while trying to collect candy.
- Loud noises such as sirens, car motors and motorcycle revving are discouraged since these can frighten children.
- In order to prevent gaps in the parade, participants must continue moving forward and are not permitted to stop and perform.
- Clubs and Organizations are limited to 3 groups or vehicles per application.
- We request that all teams, troops and tribes please wear their uniforms or matching attire and carry a sign or banner that identifies the group.
- All traffic laws must be followed including motorcyclists wearing the proper DOT approved helmets.
- **FESTIVE ATTIRE IS STRONGLY ENCOURAGED** for participants including parents and chaperones.
- The Creedmoor Christmas Parade is a rain or shine event. Please ensure your organization has appropriate weather related provisions.
